## Adaptation workshops

The Resilient Coast project team are currently preparing for a series of workshops to be held over October and November with the Douglas Shire communities. These workshops form part of the Phase 6 process in developing a Coastal Hazard Adaptation Strategy (CHAS).

These workshops will include reviewing:

- The Douglas Shire coastal values, the vision for a Resilient Coast, and objectives for different regions
- Built and natural assets that may be impacted by coastal erosion and storm tide inundation, now and into the future
- The range of adaptation options available (including planning, changes to infrastructure, coastal engineering)
- Stakeholder perspectives on adaptation options – how well do different options achieve the vision and objectives for a Resilient Coast?
- Other issues of interest to stakeholders in the context of coastal hazard management.

**Community workshops** will be held over October 31<sup>st</sup> and November 1<sup>st</sup>, at venues including Cape Tribulation, Mossman and Port Douglas.
