Strategic Plan development

The Resilient Coast program is now nearing completion. During November the project team have focused on:

- Synthesising the technical data on the risk of coastal hazards
- Refining adaptation options
- Economic analysis
- Refining recommendations for adaptation actions across the Douglas Shire.

A draft of the Douglas Shire Resilient Coast Strategic Plan is now being developed and will be available for public comment in early 2019.

The Strategic Plan has been informed by detailed technical investigations and a 12-month engagement program including input from:

- Our Douglas communities
- Douglas Shire Council
- The Stakeholder Advisory Group
- A range of special interest groups.

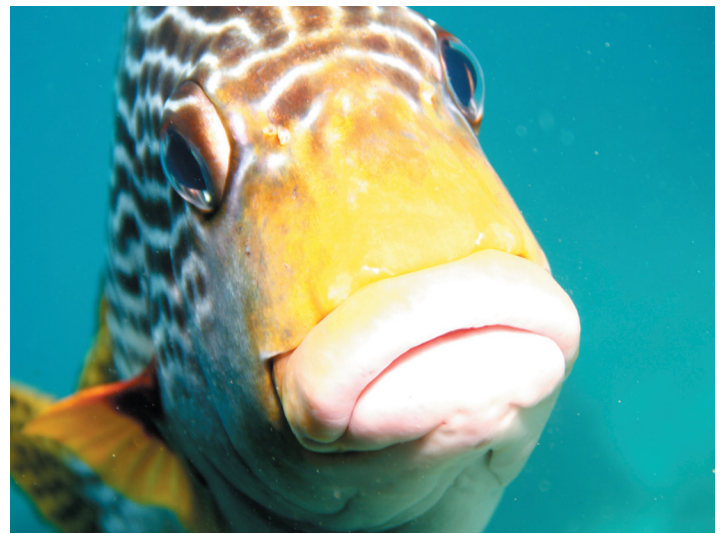
